Sunblades or architectural fins, are an aesthetic way to sun-shade a new or existing building. By including sunblades in the exterior design of a building you achieve energy efficiency with natural sunlight, contributing to Green Star ratings on buildings. Sunblades allow the natural sunlight to be filtered and the interior temperature regulated without blocking outside views.

By reducing the heat of sunlight on glass this design feature is able to achieve a cooling of the temperature of the interior while reducing the building's air conditioning system consumption. Manufactured from aluminium, Sunblades are light weight and offer low maintenance. Fitted in horizontal or vertical ways they can greatly enhance the facade of the building and make a striking visual statement. The strength and low weights make installation on construction sites easier and less expensive than heavier facade features.
